- 1. The president called the meeting to order.
- 2. Minutes of the last meeting were presented and passed.
- 3. The list of new members (25) was presented. The list was approved to be presented to the GB for admission

    - (viii) Certificate course remains a big draw for the IHPBA and the two courses were conducted at Lakeshore hospital, Kochi (June 2016) and BHU Varanasi (Sept 2016). Fantastic courses with good participation, interactive sessions and overall a great feedback. Thanks to Dr H Ramesh and Dr Puneet and their team for a fabulous course
- 5. The financial status and accounts of the organization was presented. Dr Chirag Desai had submitted the conference account status and the auditors will review and prepare the audited account statement.
- 6. It was resolved to appoint Pramod and Darshan as auditors for the IHPBA India Chapter.
- 7. Dr S Shrikhande contributed Rs 10.23 lacs from the meeting conducted in Mumbai in 2014. The EC recorded and appreciated his gesture for his contribution.
- 8. The EC was apprised of the following initiatives which were undertaken

## 9. It was resolved that

- a. The IHPBA bank account should have a modified address and email id for the treasurer and secretary to have direct access
- b. The money in the account should be wisely invested and used for fellowships and bursaries
- c. Dr S Shrikhande will formalize a standard plaque for the M J Joshi oration
- 10. Scientific content development It was resolved to enhance the scientific content by way of providing access to journals and preparing teaching modules under the guidance of Dr Sastry and Dr GV Rao
- 11. It was resolved that the proposals from industry to develop proctor ship modules at identified centers of learning be explored and presented to the EC and GBM and this has to be followed up by Dr GV Rao
- 12. It was resolved that the proposal by Dr GV Rao for publishing a "Handbook of IHPBA" be explored and finalized after due discussions
- 13. It was resolved that the proposal of Abbott to be an educational partner for the mid term meeetings be accepted without any riders.
- 14. Dr RB Yadav proposed that there should be a repository of available HPB fellowships in the country and it should be made available on the web site.
- 15. The Constitution Review Committee Convenor R Mehta, RA Sastry, C Khandelwal and SK Mathur AN Supe have made progress and shall submit the final recommendations to the EC in one month.

- 17. The EC discussed at length the status of the certificate course. Dr Sastry pointed out that some of these courses are just becoming any other conferences. It was emphasized that the mandate is for an interactive, discussion for the registrants with the faculty. The course should be standardized and there should be a max of 15 20 (5 local) faculty members and a max of 50 participants.
